QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be in **regular attendance** and an **active participant** at the Monroe Street Church of Christ
- Current High School Graduate
- Accepted/ Registered with a 2 / 4 year College or University or approved Program
- Provide proof of acceptance/registration

REQUIREMENTS:

Graduates are expected to be in regular attendance at Church during school break.


Graduates are expected to maintain a **2.5 GPA** or higher. We want to encourage all graduates to strive for excellence at all times, continually striving to excel. The committee would like to see improvement in the graduates GPA over time.

Where we do understand that things happen and sometimes students find some classes difficult to master it is important to maintain your GPA requirement. Should you fall below you will be placed on probation for one semester, giving you the opportunity to bring your GPA backup. Should you fail to obtain the **2.5 GPA** requirements the laptop is to be returned to the committee.

A Copy of the students grades are to be submitted to the committee each semester.

The committee understands that a 4 year University is not for every student. Some Students may opt to attend a trade school that will allow them to acquire the necessary skill set for life accomplishments. These programs must be presented to the Committee and they will decide if it is a qualifying program for the Laptop program.

The laptops provided are on Loan from the Monroe Street Church of Christ to the graduating student until such time as the student has completed a minimum of 2 consecutive years successfully at a qualifying College/University or approved program. In the event the student does not complete 2 consecutive, successful years of education the laptop is to be returned to the Committee or the



Student/Parent can purchase the computer from the committee in the amount of \$300.

Should your computer sustain any damage during the course of the 2 year period you are to contact a Committee member immediately so that repairs can be made in a timely manner.
